

How to install the product

Install the hardware

NOTICE

Due to local regulations or the environmental and electrical conditions in which the product is to be used, a shielded network cable (STP) may be appropriate or required. Any network cables that are routed outdoors or in demanding electrical environments shall be shielded (STP) and intended for their specific use.

NOTICE

Avoid mounting the camera towards the sun, this may cause damage to the lens and sensor.

Important

Mount the camera securely to avoid vibrations which will cause blurry video.

- 1. Mount the EF/EF-S lens on the camera body, see *How to mount the lens on page 8*.
- 2. Optionally connect external input/output devices, such as alarm devices. See *Connectors on page 14* for information on the terminal connector pins.
- 3. Optionally connect an active speaker and/or external microphone.
- 4. Connect the camera to the network using a shielded network cable (RJ45) or by using a SFP network module, see *page 10*.
- 5. Connect power, using one of the methods listed below:
 - PoE+ (Power over Ethernet, IEEE 802.3at Type 2). PoE+ is automatically detected when the network cable is connected.
 - Connect an external power adapter to the power connector block. See Connectors on page 14.
- 6. Check that the status LED indicate the correct condition. See for more details. Note that the Status LED can be configured to be unlit during normal operation.
- 7. Optionally insert a microSD card (not included) into the SD card slot.

NOTICE


To prevent corruption of recordings, the SD card should be unmounted before it is ejected.

- 8. To properly ground the product, connect a grounding wire to the grounding screw positioned near the cameras screw plate, see *Hardware overview on page 6*
- 9. Fasten the camera to a wall mount or a holder.

How to mount the lens

NOTICE

- 1. Remove the rear lens cap and the body cap.
- 2. Mount the lens by aligning the lens' red or white mount index with the camera's mount index of the same color.
- 3. Set the lens's focus mode switch to AF (autofocus).
- 4. Remove the front lens cap.
- 5. Optionally, zoom the lens by turning the zoom ring on the lens with your fingers and lock the zoom position with the supplied elastic.

How to unmount the lens

- 1. Press the unlock button, see *Product overview on page 6*.
- 2. While pressing the unlock button turn the lens anti clockwise until it stops.
- 3. Remove the lens carefully.

Fiber network connectivity (optional)

This product features an SFP slot for optional fiber network connectivity. To connect to a network you need optional SFP modules. More information available at www.axis.com

About network redundancy

The software controls the network redundancy and requires that both network connectors (RJ45 or SFP) are connected. The SFP module has higher priority than the RJ45 connector. In case of a malfunction in the SFP connection the product switches to the RJ45 connector to establish a continued connection.

To reset the product to the factory default settings:

- 1. Disconnect power from the product.
- Press and hold the control button and reconnect power. See Hardware overview on page 6.
- 3. Keep the control button pressed for 15–30 seconds until the status LED indicator flashes amber.
- 4. Release the control button. The process is complete when the status LED indicator turns green. The product has been reset to the factory default settings. If no DHCP server is available on the network, the default IP address is 192.168.0.90
- 5. Using the installation and management software tools, assign an IP address, set the password, and access the video stream.
- 6. Refocus the product.

Connectors

Network connector

RJ45 Ethernet connector with Power over Ethernet (PoE).

NOTICE

The product shall be connected using a shielded network cable (STP) or an optical fiber cable. All cables connecting the product to the network shall be intended for their specific use. Make sure that the network devices are installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. I/O connector

Use with external devices in combination with, for example, tampering alarms, motion detection, event triggering, and alarm notifications. In addition to the 0 V DC reference point and power (DC output), the I/O connector provides the interface to:

- Digital output For connecting external devices such as relays and LEDs. Connected
 devices can be activated by the VAPIX® Application Programming Interface, output
 buttons on the Live View page or by an Action Rule. The output will show as active
 (shown under System Options > Ports & Devices) if the alarm device is activated.
- Digital input For connecting devices that can toggle between an open and closed circuit, for example: PIRs, door/window contacts, glass break detectors, etc. When a signal is received the state changes and the input becomes active (shown under System Options > Ports & Devices).

Audio connector

The Axis product has the following audio connectors:

- Audio in (pink) 3.5 mm input for a mono microphone, or a line-in mono signal.
- Audio out (green) 3.5 mm output for audio (line level) that can be connected to a public address (PA) system or an active speaker with a built-in amplifier. A stereo connector must be used for audio out.



RS485/RS422 connector

Two 2-pin terminal blocks for RS485/RS422 serial interface used to control auxiliary equipment such as pan-tilt devices.

The serial port can be configured to support:

- Two-wire RS485 half duplex
- Four-wire RS485 full duplex
- Two-wire RS422 simplex
- Four-wire RS422 full duplex point to point communication





Battery

The Axis product uses a 3.0 V BR2330 lithium battery as the power supply for its internal real-time clock (RTC). Under normal conditions this battery will last for a minimum of five years.

Low battery power affects the operation of the RTC, causing it to reset at every power-up. When the battery needs replacing, a log message will appear in the product's server report. For more information about the server report, see the product's setup pages or contact Axis support.

The battery should not be replaced unless required, but if the battery does need replacing, contact Axis support at www.axis.com/techsup for assistance.

Lithium coin cell 3.0 V batteries contain 1,2-dimethoxyethane; ethylene glycol dimethyl ether (EGDME), CAS no. 110-71-4.
